We are committed to providing emergency food assistance to low-income seniors over the age of 60 through the Commodity Senior Food Program (CSFP). Eligible older adults receive a monthly food package consisting of all 5 major food groups and a loaf of cheese from their local participating United Food Bank partner agencies.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Be 60 years of age or older (Must show photo ID and proof of Arizona residency to apply)
- Meet the annual household income requirements
