February 25, 2011

The workshop began at 9:00 am with introductions of all present.

Mr. Hauser explained that 3 designated steps, # 1 - Vision, #2 - What do we want the future of Springerville to look like in 3 to 5 years and #3 - Identify specific action steps to move the town toward the vision created and specifically overcome barriers and obstacles.

He asked that specific ideas, direction vision and areas of importance be identified for each department as well as things that they want to accomplish in the next 3 to 5 years. To clarify "Vision" he said not to take into account the restrictions of the current budget conditions.

Councilmember's and staff were broken into groups to address specific topics with subtopics, i.e.

- "WHAT CREATIVE AND INNOVATIVE ACTION WILL DEAL WITH THE CONTRADICTIONS" AND MOVE US TOWARD THE VISION"
- "WHAT ARE THE ROADBLOCKS, BARRIERS, AND CONTRADICTIONS THAT KEEP US FROM MOVING TOWARD OUR VISION"?"
- "WHAT ARE THE FUTURE DIRECTIONS, PRIORITIES AND VISIONS FOR SPRINGERVILLE OVER THE NEXT 3 – 5 YEARS"?"

At the end of the session Mr. Hauser said he would send all the information gathered today and send it to the manager to put into spread sheets for distribution.

The attached summary is the outcome of the workshop.

The meeting adjourned around 3:00 p.m.
