Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond executed by a Surety Company or a certified check in an amount not less than ten (10) percent of the total bid made payable to the Town of Springerville.

The Bidder must supply all the information required by the proposal forms and specifications and must bid on all items of every schedule. The Town of Springerville reserves the right to waive any informality in, or to reject any or all portions of, the various bid items. No proposal may be withdrawn for a period of 90 days from the opening thereof.

A non-mandatory in-person pre-bid meeting will be on July 1, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. (MST) at the Springerville Municipal Airport. Following the pre-bid meeting, prospective bidders will have the opportunity to tour the project site.
