Round Valley has a year-round estimated population of 6,600, although this increases with the summer visitors. Enjoy hiking through hundreds of miles of public land trails, skiing the slopes of nearby Sunrise Ski resort, fishing in the many local lakes and rivers, and incredible hunting for big and small game. SUMMARY:

The Round Valley Police Department is recruiting for applicants to attend the Police Academy and ultimately become a certified police officer. The Towns of Springerville & Eagar have recently consolidated their public safety to become the **NEW Round Valley Police Department**. Once you have completed the academy, under general supervision, officers will patrol the Towns, respond to crime and accident scenes, emergency situations, apprehend and arrest criminals and enforces the laws of the Towns.

All applicants will be required to pass pre-hire testing and an AZ POST background investigation.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

US citizen; high school graduate or GED; Must be 21 years old; ability to obtain an Arizona driver's license; ability to meet AZPOST requirements

Veteran preferences shall be as provided per A.R.S § 38-492
