DUE TO COVID-19, TOWN OF SPRINGERVILLE BUILDINGS WILL HAVE LIMITED ACCESS BEGINNING TUESDAY, MARCH 24 at 8:00 a.m.

Access will be by appointment only

Springerville, Ariz. (March 23, 2020) – Beginning Tuesday, March 24, at 8:00 a.m., Town Hall, Heritage Museum, Airport, Fire Station, Parks and Public Works' Offices will be closed to foot traffic to limit public access and to reduce face-to-face contact. The policy will be in effect until further notice. All town facilities will remain staffed; however, in-person services will be limited until the COVID-19 risk subsides. The Town's parks will also be closed.

Town business will be by appointment only by calling (928) 333-2656. Utility payments can be made by phone (928) 333-2656, online at XpressBillPay.com, or through our drop box located next to Town Hall's entrance.

The Community Services Department has implemented operational changes. The Senior Center Department building can be accessed by appointment only. Transportation will be provided for medical appointments and purchasing food between Monday and Thursday. Appointments can be scheduled by calling (928) 245-2528. All meals will be provided on Tuesdays and Thursdays. All other operations will remain the same.
